Latest Update on the 2025 GES Promotion Exercise

The Ghana Education Service has commenced the 2025 promotion process nationwide. As part of the exercise:

- **Index numbers have been sent via SMS** to all shortlisted candidates.
- The **full list of shortlisted teachers** has been forwarded to **District, Municipal, Metro, and Regional Education Directorates** for verification.
- Candidates who have **not received SMS notifications** are advised to check with their respective education offices.

Each SMS contains the candidate's **Staff ID, Index Number, and designated Examination Centre**.

2025 GES Promotion Examination Dates and Time

The promotion examinations will be written over **two days**, based strictly on rank:

Monday, 29th December 2025

- **Ranks:** Principal Superintendent (PS), Assistant Director II (AD II)
- **Time:** 9:00 am – 12:00 noon

Tuesday, 30th December 2025

- **Ranks:** Assistant Director I (AD I), Deputy Director (DD)
- **Time:** 9:00 am – 12:00 noon

Candidates are advised to arrive at their centres early to allow time for verification and seating.

- **Format:** Multiple Choice and True/False

Assistant Director II (AD II)

- **Total Questions:** 70
- **Format:** Multiple Choice and True/False

Assistant Director I (AD I)

- **Total Questions:** 70
- **Format:** Multiple Choice and True/False

Deputy Director (DD)

- **Total Questions:** 70
- **Format Breakdown:**
 - 50 Multiple Choice / True or False
 - 20 Fill-in Questions

The inclusion of fill-in questions at the Deputy Director level reflects the strategic and policy-driven nature of the role.
